Introduction

The places of military glory of Kaluga region of Zhukov district (Student's guide book)

Настоящее пособие рассчитано на школьников, студентов и учителей школ.

Авторы-составители этой книги видят свою задачу в том, чтобы помочь учащимся совершенствовать свои знания и развивать навыки устной речи, используя материалы о местах боевой славы Калужской области Жуковского района. Пособие позволяет заниматься данной темой как под руководством учителя в классе, так и самостоятельно. В книге представлен актуальный познавательный материал об истории.

Пособие состоит из 6 частей. Каждая часть имеет свое название: Кременки, Троицкое, Стрелковка, Екатериновка, Боровна, Малеево. Все эти места имеют свою историю. На основе этого материала авторы составили англо-русский словарь. К каждому тексту подобраны разнообразные упражнения, позволяющие не только провести контроль знаний по теме, но и расширить кругозор по ней.

Пособие не предполагает систематической сплошной проработки. Можно рекомендовать использовать материал периодически, наряду с основной работой над языком по другим учебникам, для самостоятельного чтения и для проработки и обсуждения в классе тем.

Kremyonki

I live in a small town Kremyonki of Kaluga Region of Zhukov District. Kremyonki is famous for its history. In September, 1941 the Nazis devised a plan to capture Moscow. The operation was called "Typhoon". The Nazis hoped to get our capital at one blow. They wanted to destroy the entire population of Moscow, blow up the city and create an artificial sea on this place. They hoped to wipe out the memory of Moscow. 77 divisions of the Germans were thrown to this district. Despite the fact that the forces were unequal our soldiers, our defenders managed to defend the routes of approach to Moscow. Kremyonki -Troitskoe – Borovna – Ekaterinovka – Maleevo are the places of military glory of our district. From this point the victorious March of the 49th Army to the West began. On this line more than 16 thousand of the defenders of our homeland were killed. At the entrance to the city there is a Memorial complex of military valor and glory. In the memory of the fallen defenders of Moscow in autumn 1941 on the beautiful hill on the 9th of May in 1968 the obelisk was opened on Victory Day. It is carved with unforgettable words: "Years and centuries will pass, but those who gave peace, calm to the earth, happiness to people will always remain to the world in the heart of human memory."

Troitskoe Village

Location: Kaluga Region, Zhukov District.

On the edge of the village there is a military burial. It arose in December 1941, when local residents had buried the Soviet soldiers of the 60th and the 149th infantry divisions and other parts, who died in November-December 1941, in the battles for the liberation Ershova, Potashnikova, Troitskoe. There are two burial mounds, which are covered with turf. In the sixties of the last century a monument was erected on the mass grave. On a two-stage concrete pedestal

height of 1.2 m installed two-meter height sculptural group: the figures of two soldiers (a man and a woman) with their heads bowed sorrowfully.

Woman holding the right hand banner in the hands of a man wreath. A concrete slab with the inscription is attached to the pedestal: "Eternal glory to the heroes who died in the battles for the Motherland in 1941-1945". To the right of the monument on metal supports are framed with a metal frame nine memorial plates with the names of the buried. All in the grave lie the remains of 693 soldiers.

Chapter 3

Strelkovka Village

Location: Kaluga Region, Zhukov District, Strelkovka Village, 3 kilometers from Zhukov city.

It is a historically significant place.

This village is the birthplace of the great man. Georgy Konstantinovich Zhukov is the famous commander, a four-time Hero of the Soviet Union, the Marshal of the Victory. Zhukov was born

in the village of Strelkovka, not far from Moscow, in the poor family of farmers. During the Great Patriotic War, he proved as the talented commander who has played the major role in defeat of the fascist armies in the Leningrad and Moscow fights. The bronze bust and monuments are established to Zhukov.

The memorial is built in the village. The museum exhibition is organized in the house where Georgy Zhukov grew up. It was opened after restoration on the 1st of December 2016 in the day of the 120th anniversary of the commander. It contains real household items in the rural life style decore.

There are plaques with information about Georgy Zhukov and photos with reconstruction stages of the house. Among the presented exhibits of the House Museum you can see: extract «about the birth» from the register of births, exact copy of the award «Red Banner» (Georgy Zhukov was awarded with this award in 1922, it was his first award), also his personal belongings — watches, shoulder straps, blocks, and other unique exhibits. The architectural and sculptural composition «Marshall's Homeland of Zhukov» was built here in 1988 (the architect —

Kireev E.I., the sculptor – Dumanyan V.H.).

Chapter 4

Ekaterinovka Village

Location: Kaluga Region, Zhukovsky District.

It is a place of memory of the died soldiers. Here was the line «Drakino-Troitskoye-Kremyonki-Borovna-Pavlovka-Ekaterinovka-Maleevo». Here soldiers of 49 armies stopped the German aggressors going to Moscow in October – December, 1941. At this boundary memorial complexes and brotherly burials in memory of the immortal feat of soldiers were erected.

There is a mass grave in Ekaterinovka. The mass grave is in the center of the village. It was erected in December, 1941 when locals had buried the Soviet soldiers who had been killed in the battles of Ekaterinovka here. The monument has been built near the grave. The monument represents soldier's figures with mournfully hung naked head holding a banner and a woman holding a wreath. Ashes of 669 soldiers are based in this grave.

Chapter 5

The village on the edge of the city of Kremyonki, at the road fork of Kurchatovets-Ekaterinovka.

Location: Kaluga Region, Zhukovsky District.

There is a mass grave iin the village, which was founded by forces of the search groups on the 9th October, 1994. Here the remains of the found Soviet soldiers were buried along the Borovna River by the search groups. The flower bed is broken on the grave. The monument has been built on the concrete pedestal with the size of 2,2 x 1,2 x 1 m with the concrete rectangular obelisk in height of 3,5 m, width of 1,5 m, and thickness of 0,33 m. In the top of the obelisk there is a metal image of the Red Star. There are five marble plaques with names of buried soldiers. There are ashes of more than 141 soldiers in the grave. 23 more names and initials of the fallen soldiers were added to the Memory blocks in 2011.

In the village of Ekaterinovka the private museum was founded in eighties. In the «Museum of Military Glory» you will get acquainted with the military artifacts collected by

search groups in the neighborhood of the village.

Chapter 6

Maleevo Village

Location: Kaluga Region, Zhukovsky District.

«Maleevo» is one of memorials in honor of soldiers and officers who battled against fascist aggressors on the line «Drakino-Troitskoye-Kremyonki-Borovna-Pavlovka-Ekaterinovka-Maleevo». This place is called «An Unsubdued Boundary». The reason of erecting of this memorial is that fighters of the 49th army stopped the German aggressors breaking to Moscow in October-December, 1941.

Now there is a field there, there is the obelisk to defenders of Moscow – soldiers of the 1st division of the National Militia of Leninsky District of the capital. The Obelisk is in the middle of the field where a village had been before. During the war there was the German military unit

here – a strong point of Germans. The village was completely destroyed in October-December, 1941 after the battles. The memorial complex is finished by the Stele of the Goddess of Nick. The stele of the Goddess of Victory of Nick was founded on the 14^{th} December , 1991 in honor of the died soldiers. There are a mass grave and 10 commemorative plaques with names of buried soldiers.
